- Bachelor Degree
- Other qualifications may provide full or partial exemption from modules off the UBIS MAIR. Official certified high school transcript and/or university transcript (final transcript of grades and courses) must be provided to UBIS admissions office
- TOEFL or other official English placement exam results (If your previous schooling has not been in English or Non-Native English speakers). Have all results submitted to our office directly from the testing agency.
- Two passport photos
- CV/Resume
- Motivation letter (Max 250 words)
